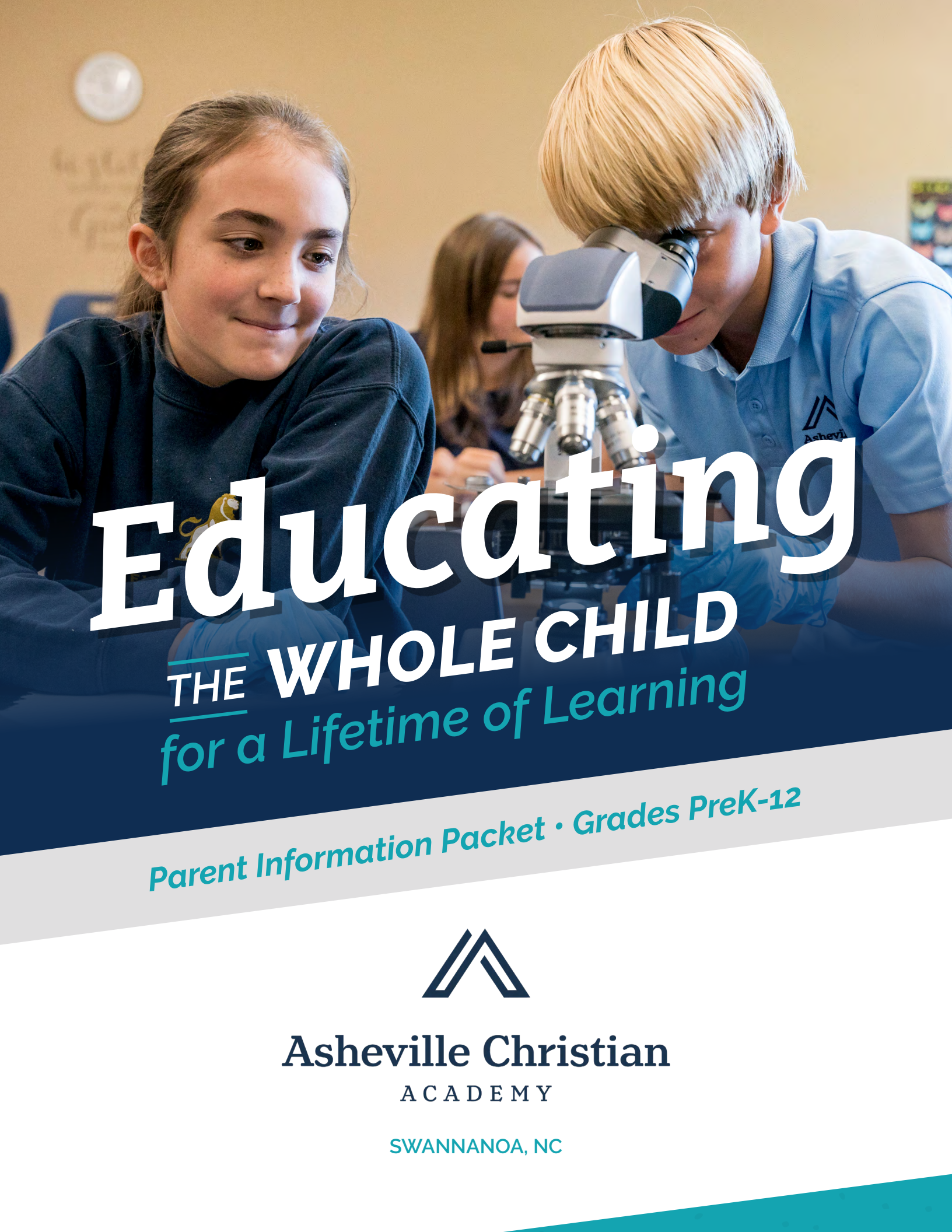

Pre-Kindergarten *(Ages 4-5 years)*

***A loving, safe environment
where creativity and playful
learning meet***

Our primary goal at this age is to help children experience the fun and joy that lead to an early excitement about learning.

At ACA, your child will:

- Learn through multisensory activities, such as spelling out letters with their bodies and using hand motions for Bible memory verses
- Feel valued with smaller class sizes (8:1 student-teacher ratio)
- Explore the wonders of God's creation in science through biblically integrated teaching
- Develop a solid foundation through early literacy and numeracy activities

As a pre-kindergarten parent, you can expect:

- Dedicated staff who will love and care for your child within a gospel-centered learning environment
- The nurturing of a biblical worldview for your child, beginning as early as four years old
- A commitment to preparing your child for kindergarten, with careful attention to academic and spiritual growth
- Close partnership that includes open, friendly communication between home and school

Building a strong foundation for lifelong learners

Lower school students are engaged in hands-on exploration in a socially and emotionally supportive space. It's a time when deep and lasting friendships are formed, and students are challenged in an atmosphere that is collaborative and nurturing. Our small class sizes allow for differentiated instruction, which honors children as individuals who learn and develop at their own pace.



Academic Development

Students will find our curriculum fun and challenging. Core subjects include Bible, math, language arts, science, history, and geography. The engaging, hands-on learning approach brings every class to life.



Spiritual Formation

At ACA, our commitment to Christian values goes beyond Bible class. We partner with parents by encouraging students to exemplify good character in areas of conduct, speech, love, faith, and purity.



Enriching Electives

Art, music, library, and physical education enhance the core curriculum. Computer classes start in second grade. Students engage in service projects for local and global missions. The ACA Excel program provides after-school enrichment in academics, fine arts, and athletics.

Cultivating emerging gifts and academic interests

Middle school is when our students really start to come into their own. They're busy discovering new passions and talents while also starting to better understand who they are and what they stand for. We prepare them for what's ahead by challenging them with a more rigorous curriculum and encouraging them to be more involved in our learning community.

At Asheville Christian Academy, we introduce middle schoolers to what's possible and instill in them the confidence and spiritual foundation they need to achieve it:

- Master core subjects, empower independent learners, and explore courses that personally interest them
- Nurturing faith through Bible programs, school-wide events, and retreats that inspire the pursuit of God-given gifts
- Explore growth opportunities through cocurricular activities that include art, band, choir, video editing, technical theatre, drama, foreign languages, and STEM



- Develop healthy relationships with peers and mentors through involvement in clubs, student organizations, and team sports
- Strengthen important life skills needed for success in upper school, college, and careers, including self-discipline, initiative, teamwork, and empathy
